CAN MY CHILD ATTEND A TRIAL CLASS FIRST?

Yes, absolutely. We offer trial classes where your child can attend a class, so you can

it's the right fit for your child, with no commitment. Please notes, trials can only be accommodated if the class has vacancies.

CAN I GET A REFUND?

Fees are non-refundable. Class fees are paid upfront via Direct debit by the term and cancellation can only occur once a term is complete. Written notice must be given to cancel the following term by the end of the current term.

In extenuating circumstances, ie: a sustained injury, a credit may be applied at the discretion of the Principal. No refunds for holidays taken during school term.

CAN I DROP OFF AND PICK UP?

Yes, absolutely! Our permit regulations state that our car park is a 2 minute drop off zone. There is also street parking.

It is also a requirement of all children under 12 to be walked in and out of the building by a Parent or Guardian.

CAN I ATTEND A MAKE UP CLASS?

No, we don't offer make up classes in 2024.

IS THERE A COMPULSORY CONCERT/ PERFORMANCE?

We have 2 shows per year. Neither are compulsory but they are a whole lot of fun and a great way to boost confidence in your child! Our Mid year showcase is a fun, low-key chance for the students to get accustomed to the stage, before our exciting End of year performance. Mid -year is performed in their class uniform. End of Year Concert you receive costumes. There is more information about Concerts in our Parent Portal section of the website.

CAN PARENTS WATCH THE CLASS?

In our experience students are able to concentrate better without the distraction of other noise in the room from parents and other siblings. They may also feel more at ease without the pressure of being watched. As students participate in classes they have the opportunity to develop additional secure attachments with adults (teachers) and peers. This helps them transition positively into the larger world and helps with school readiness.

Having said that, a lot of children are timid at first and need to know that a parent is close by. We suggest waiting in the foyer the first class or two, if you think they may need you. We do have a viewing window that you can see through.

WILL MY CHILD TAKE EXAMS?

Our Ballet, Tap and Acro students may take an optional exam, fees apply. Your teachers will discuss if this may be an option for your child.

FEES

There is a \$45 yearly registration fee, charged upon registering. This is non refundable. Capped at \$70 per family.

45 min classes - \$18 per class, invoiced by the term 1 hour classes - \$21 per class, invoiced by the term.
